Lithium Balance lander millioninvestering og global distributionsaftale

Den amerikanske teknologikoncern Sensata Technologies – en af verdens førende og tidlige innovatører i missionskritiske sensorer og styresystemer – bliver global distributør og medejer af danske Lithium Balance. "Har afgørende betydning for at få aftaler med de store bil- og industriproducenter", siger den danske CEO.

Sensata Technologies er en af verdens førende leverandører af sensorer og styresystemer til bl.a. transport-, bygge og industrisektorerne, herunder bilindustrien.

Sensata skyder pt. 3 millioner ind som kapitalforhøjelse i Lithium Balance, og indskyder yderligere 18 millioner i januar 2020. Så det bliver en samlet kapitalforhøjelse på 21 mio kroner.

Derudover køber Sensata også Lithium Balance-aktier af det danske holdingselskab DS 7 ApS. Når hele handlen er gennemført til januar, vil Sensata have en ejerandel på 24 procent.

- Partnerskabet styrker vores mulighed for at få adgang til bilindustrien, den industrielle sektor samt tunge køretøjer og off-road, siger Lars Barkler, adm. direktør i Lithium Balance.

- Investeringen vil desuden gå til fortsatte vækstaktiviteter og produktudvikling, som inkluderer fælles teknologiprojekter, siger han.

Lithium Balance har eksisteret i tretten år, har fabrik og hovedkontor i Smørum og er både kendt for at levere batteristyresystemer til elbiler og maskiner – samt for produktion af energilagringssystemer til solcelleanlæg og regulering af elnettet.

Lithium Balance har blandt andet produceret kæmpebatterierne i Ballen Havn på Samsø samt Trigeparken i Aarhus.

Lithium Balance lands million investment and global distribution agreement

The American technology company Sensata Technologies – a world leader and early innovator in mission-critical sensors and controls – becomes the global distributor and co-owner of Danish Lithium Balance. "It will greatly enhance our ability to get supply agreements with the major car and industrial manufacturers," says the Danish CEO.

Sensata Technologies is one of the world's leading suppliers of sensors and control systems to the transport, construction and industrial sectors, which includes the automotive industry.

Now, Sensata invests DKK 3 million capital in Lithium Balance, and DKK 18 million more in January 2020 for a total investment of DKK 21 million.

Furthermore, Sensata also buys Lithium Balance-shares from the Danish holding company DS 7 ApS. When everything is completed in January 2020, Sensata will have a total ownership of 24 percent.

"This partnership will greatly enhance our ability to access heavy vehicle and off-road, industrial and automotive markets", says Lars Barkler, CEO of Lithium Balance.

"The investment will also fund growth activities and further product development, which includes joint technology projects" he says.

Lithium Balance was founded thirteen years ago, has its headquarters outside Copenhagen and is both known for supplying battery management systems for electric cars and machines, and for the production of energy storage systems for PV systems and to regulate the electricity grid. Lithium Balance has for example produced the large battery systems in Ballen Harbor on Samsø and Trigeparken in Aarhus.
